- A. 10-09-DR: Kuna’s Support Service Building - Additional Parking** – 711 E. Porter Street – south of E. Porter Street between N. Kay Ave. and N. Linder Road - The Kuna School District, represented by Layne Saxton, is requesting a design review for additional parking associated with the support service building and the existing Teed & Hubbard Elementary Schools. The proposed parking lot, which will have 620’ of frontage along E. Porter Street, will create approximately 119 additional parking spaces including 4 ADA parking spaces. The additional parking will provide parking accommodations to all of the school properties along Kay and Porter Street (including the High School) to minimize on street parking during overflow events such as: Community sports, school specials, teacher conferences, etc.; which, in turn, would help minimize traffic safety issues.
