



Kuna City Police care about your safety. We encourage you to follow these some simple steps to help keep your family safe and your home and vehicle protected.

---

### LIGHTING

- ✦ Keep inside lights on, even when you're away. Lights give the impression someone is home.
- ✦ Use adequate outdoor lighting to eliminate hiding places around your house

### LANDSCAPING

- ✦ Trim trees and bushes where a criminal could hide, especially near doors and windows.
- ✦ Provide plenty of light on areas of dense shrubs & trees that could serve as hiding places.

### EXTERIOR DOORS

- ✦ All exterior doors should be metal or solid wood.
- ✦ Every entry door should be well-lighted & have wide-angle door viewer (peephole) so you can see who is outside without opening the door.

### LOCKS

- ✦ Always keep doors & windows locked. Strong, reliable locks are essential to effective home security.
- ✦ All exterior doors should have a deadbolt lock, and you should use it

### VEHICLES

Vehicle burglaries are challenging crimes to investigate, yet one of the easiest crimes to prevent. To keep your vehicle secure:

- ✦ Always lock all doors
- ✦ Roll windows all the way up
- ✦ Park in well-lighted areas.
- ✦ Don't leave valuables in sight.
- ✦ Don't hide spare keys – they can be found.
- ✦ Keep your garage door opener with you or well-secured.
- ✦ Car alarms are only moderately effective.

### GARAGE

Almost all garage burglaries occur in open garages.

- ✦ Keep your garage doors closed and side doors locked.
- ✦ Keep valuable items out of sight
- ✦ Keep it locked. Padlock the locking slide bar when you're on vacation.
- ✦ Replace hollow core house entry doors with solid core doors & deadbolts.
- ✦ Secure windows.
- ✦ Use a random code garage door opener on a separate power switch.
- ✦ Keep outdoor lights on all night or install a motion-activated light.
- ✦ Keep locking mechanisms and door track in good repair and lubricated.
